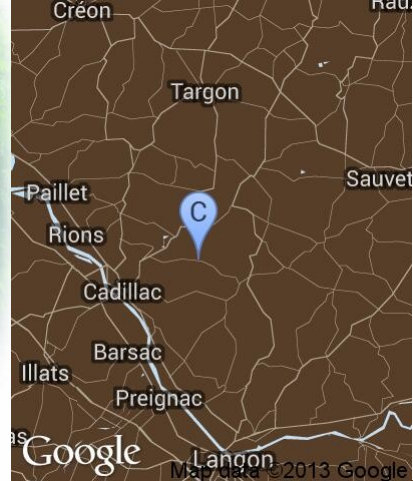
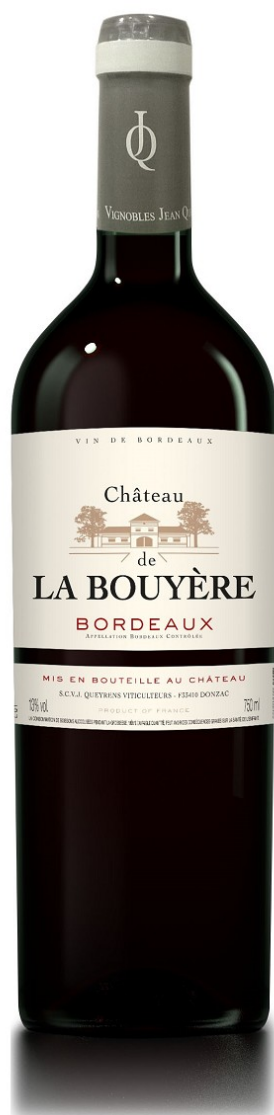




CHÂTEAU DE LA BOUYÈRE 2016

This vineyard is located at the top of Donzac, 45 km south of Bordeaux.

Grape production, wine making and ageing take place on the family estate.

In vats for 6 months with 20% of staves.

Blending

Merlot : 60%

Cabernet-sauvignon : 30%

Cabernet franc : 10%

Tasting note

Dressed with a beautiful garnet color and a deep brilliance. The powerful nose who gives a bouquet of red fruits crisp, we can easily find aromas of blackcurrant and blackberry complemented by spicy notes. The mouth follows the same aromatic line, round, generous, ample and balanced, range of savory tannins promising a bright future.
