Grape variety	100% Cabernet Sauvignon grown on the estate
Alcohol	14.1%
Harvest dates	From Sept.10, 2020 to Oct. 1, 2020
Harvest	Hand harvested from our oldest hillside vineyard.
Winemaking	Gentle de-stemming, optical sorting to ensure the best whole berries are utilized. Grapes are transferred to fermentation vessels by gravity and left to cold soak for up to 5 days. Fermentation temperature control, with gentle manipulations by pump-overs and punch-downs. After 30 days in tanks the wine is drained, pressed, and undergoes a naturally occurring malolactic fermentation in new French oak.
Barrel-aging	18 months, 80% new French oak plus some special vats.

"A dense aromatic profile of earth, dark plum, Valrhona chocolate, tobacco and spice dominate the nose.

The palate is rich and round with seamless velvety tannins. A focused acidity complimented with a balanced, complete mouthfeel leads to a finish that displays the very best of the terroir farmed by Cathiard Vineyard. "
