The 2023 vintage was aged in barrel for 14-16 months, of which 50% new and 50% single use barrels.

Cabernet Sauvignon : 21 September

Tasting notes

The 2023 vintage finds its rightful place among the estate's recent great successes, on a par with 2019 and 2020, with a hint of elegance and freshness to allure enthusiasts of great Pomerol wines. The intense garnet appearance already signals a wine of great body. On the bouquet, expressive aromas of ripe fruits, dominated by black cherries, blueberries and a delicate floral note of peonies. Initially supple and rounded on the palate, rapidly balanced out with freshness.

The 2023 vintage could easily age a further fifteen years to acquire its full, integrated expression.
