Owned by the Dubourg family, Chateau Nicot is based in the town of Escoussans, less than 22 miles south-east of Bordeaux, on the right bank of the River Garonne, this domain has enjoyed an enviable reputation for over two hundred years.

Wine making

Traditional winemaking in stainless steel thermo-regulated vats.

Ageing

In tanks and barrels (renewed for 33% every year) for 15 months and fined with egg-white

Blending

Cabernet-sauvignon : 70%
Merlot : 30%

Tasting note

A beautiful clear ruby color with purple reflections. The nose develops little by little with black fruit and red berry aromas. Elegant with a smooth attack that becomes more powerful. The finish is delicate, yielding a wine that can be enjoyed now but can be kept few years.
