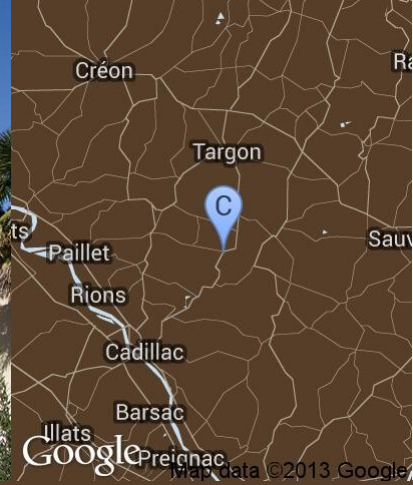




CHÂTEAU NICOT 2015

Owned by the Dubourg family, Chateau Nicot is based in the town of Escoussans, less than 22 miles south-east of Bordeaux, on the right bank of the River Garonne, this domain has enjoyed an enviable reputation for over two hundred years.

Wine making

Traditional winemaking in stainless steel thermo-regulated vats.

Ageing

In stainless steel tanks and barrels (renewed for 33% every year) for 15 months and fined with egg-white.

Blending

Cabernet-sauvignon : 65%
Merlot : 35%

Tasting note

This wine has a ruby red colour with a fresh nose with fruity notes, distinct and neat in mouth, keeping the finesse and the material. A longlasting and smooth final which is very pleasant.
