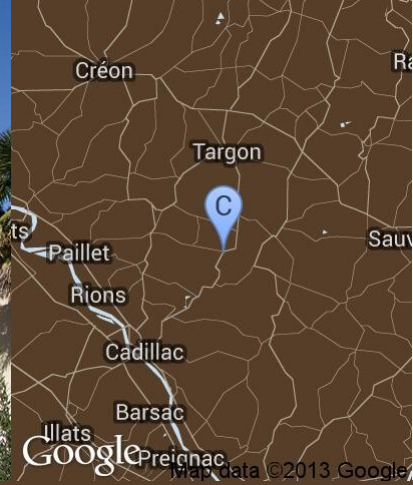




CHÂTEAU NICOT 2017

Owned by the Dubourg family, Chateau Nicot is based in the town of Escoussans, less than 22 miles south-east of Bordeaux, on the right bank of the River Garonne, this domain has enjoyed an enviable reputation for over two hundred years.

Wine making

Traditional vinification in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks, with precipitation of tartar with cold.

Ageing

For 4 months in tanks.

Blending

Cabernet franc : 70%
Merlot : 30%

Tasting note

A dry and fruity wine, the palate is fresh and lively.
